

Deadline and Submission Requirements for Bachelor's and Master's Theses in the Summer Semester of the Academic Year 2024/2025 and Obtaining Credit for the Courses:

E373992 – Bachelor's Thesis

E373990 – Master's Thesis

To obtain credit for courses E373992 Bachelor's Thesis (Bachelor's study) and E373990 Master's Thesis (Master's study), students must submit the respective final thesis (Bachelor's Thesis for E373992, Master's Thesis for E373990) within the deadline specified in this directive. This directive also defines the format and method of submission for the respective university final thesis (hereinafter referred to as BT for Bachelor's Thesis and MT for Master's Thesis).

1) Deadline for Submission of Final Theses (BT and MT)

For the summer semester of the academic year 2024/2025, the final deadline for submission of bachelor's and master's theses is **August 8, 2025**.

To obtain credit for courses E373992 and E373990, the following submission deadlines must be met:

- a) To be eligible to defend the thesis and take the State Final Examination during the period June 16–27, 2025 (June term), students must submit their Bachelor's or Master's Thesis in the KOS Student Information System and also submit one printed copy of the thesis no later than May 30, 2025.
- b) To be eligible for the State Final Examination during the period August 25 – September 5, 2025 (August term), students must submit their Bachelor's or Master's Thesis in the KOS Student Information System and also submit one printed copy of the thesis no later than August 8, 2025.

2) Format and Method of Submission of Final Theses (BT and MT)

University final theses (Bachelor's and Master's Theses) must be submitted electronically via the KOS Student Information System. Additionally, students are required to submit one printed copy of their BT or MT in comb binding to the Secretariat of Department Ú 12110, in accordance with the deadlines stated in section 1 of this directive.

Further requirements regarding the scope and formatting of the thesis are available at moodle.cvut.cz, in course B242-E373990 Master's Thesis.

This directive enters into force on April 7, 2025.
